

FIND YOUR (or someone elses) RING SIZE

Method 1: Measure a ring you already have.

Print out this guide using standard A4 sized paper (210 x 297mm). Using a ring that correctly fits the finger that you are purchasing the ring for, place is over the circles below until the inside circumference of the ring aligns with a circle.



Method 2: If you are unable to print this off & don't have a ring sizer.

Simply get a ruler to measure the inside diameter of an existing ring you have, in millimeters & refer to the mm measurements for each size before you get a match (or as close as possible) If you fit between two sizes then it is likely you will need a 1/2 size. For example if you are 18.95mm you would be best suited to an R 1/2.

^{*}You must make sure you start on Omm and not the end of the ruler for this to be accurate.
